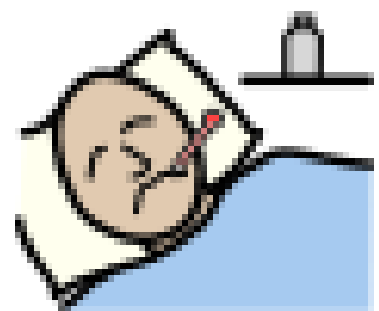
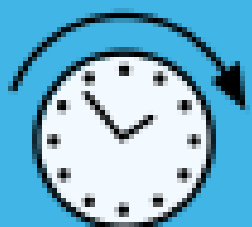


My child is unwell. How do I get help?



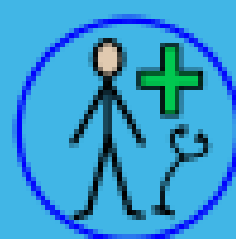
If your child becomes unwell during the coronavirus outbreak you can still get help. It is important to get help whether it is coronavirus or something else.



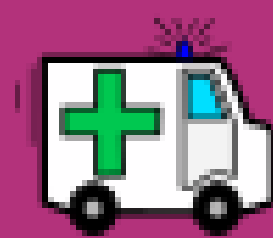
Don't delay! Get help if you are worried about your child.



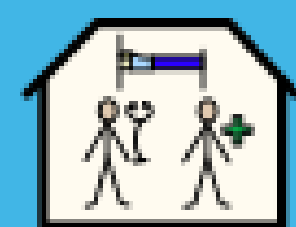
You can still call NHS 111



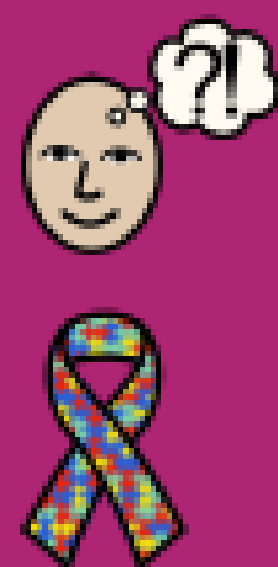
You can still call your GP



You can still call 999 or go to A&E if your child's illness needs urgent help.



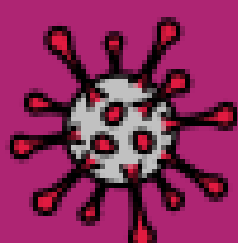
If your child needs to go to hospital, one of you can stay with your child. We will work with you if you need to swap with someone else or go home.



If you look after someone aged 18-25 with special needs, you can be supported if they need to go to hospital. You can stay with them if they need it. If they have a learning difficulty, call 023 9228 6000 extension 5825 for more support, otherwise speak to the hospital staff.
