# English

In English, the children will be learning how to write to interest the reader. This will involve them choosing language carefully, making use of a full range of punctuation and using a range of different sentence structures to make their writing flow. The children will do this through their study of Macbeth, a Shakespeare play, where they will look at characterisation and write diaries and letters.

### PΕ

This half term, the children will be developing their football skills, including how to pass and shoot with accuracy.

### Music

Our class will continue to develop our understanding of notation and keeping to a rhythm using Charanga.

# History/Geography

In our Frozen Kingdom topic, the children will be learning both geographical and historical skills. These include direction and positioning, including how to follow maps using 8-figure grid referencing. The children will also explore ice bergs. The children will also learn about the Titanic and the fantastic journey of explorer, Matthew Henson.

### Computing

Children will be learning how to programme using Scratch. They will programme an arcade game using coding.

#### RE

In RE, children will be learning about 'Humanism' across a range of faiths and non-faiths, identifying the core beliefs.

### Spanish

The children will be continuing to develop their knowledge and understanding of Spanish, both written and spoken.

### Maths

In maths, the children will be exploring Place Value in which they will be working with numbers up to 10 million. The children will use resources to support their understanding of the value of each digit in preparation for addition and subtraction which will be the unit that follows after. Place Value will be extremely important for their understanding of number and will be the backbone of their knowledge.

#### Science

This 'Light" unit will teach the children about how light moves, how we see colour and shadows, and how light can be refracted and reflected. The class will have many opportunities to work scientifically and collaboratively to investigate how shadows are formed and how light can be refracted and reflected.

#### **PSHE**

In PSHE, the children will be looking at setting goals and learning how to develop positive relationships.

## Art

During art this term, we will be finding out about how portraits have evolved over time, developing our drawing skills-specifically proportion, form, space and value.
