

Maths

- Children will be learning the value of numbers.
- We will be learning to add and subtract numbers.
- We will be practising our times tables and learning how to use 'Times Tables Rock Stars' - an exciting online maths game.

English

- Much of our English writing will be based around our class book, 'Evie and the Animals' and our science learning on animals.
- Children will write simile poems and learn how to describe characters and settings.
- We will revise objectives from the year 2 curriculum as well as recapping key spellings.
