Art

- The children will be making Beaker style clay pots and weaving using paper.

Topic

- We will investigate different eras of history - the Stone Age, the Bronze Age and the Iron Age.
- We will be studying how life changed over these different periods of Pre-Historic Britain and look at how people evolved during these eras.
- Part of our study will focus on tools, weaponry and clothing from these ancient periods.
